

Catalog Migration Guide

The v1 and v2 versions of the Catalog API are being deprecated and will be phased out at a later time. Please refer to the following migration guide to get started with Catalog API v3.

Important! The older versions will be discontinued according to the following schedule:

- **Catalog API v1** will be discontinued in **June 2021**
- **Catalog API v2** will be discontinued in **December 2021**

Migrate from v1 and v2 to v3

- The location of the customer id has been changed:
 - Migrating from v1: The usage of your default customer id is removed and should from now on be sent as header X-Customer-Id instead.
 - Migrating from v2: {customerId} is removed from the url path and should from now on be sent as header X-Customer-Id instead.
- All references towards stock and availabilityDate for one or more skus have been removed from the Catalog API.
- The ref field (containing an url to the style color details) was removed from the styleColor reference object, please refer to the GetStyleColor operation.
- Specific for pagination:
 - Query parameters offset and limit were removed from the request in favor of page and size.
Example: a request with parameters { offset=20, limit=10 } becomes { page=2, size=10 } and will yield the same results.
 - Parameters next and previous were removed from the response. You can use the newly added size, number and totalElements instead.
Example: if size * number < totalElements, a next page is available. If number != 0, a previous page is available.
 - Parameter totalCount in the response was renamed to totalElements.

Example of the new paging response:
